## DAILY SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES

- ◆ Read a story to your Baby Bear. Tell the story from looking at the pictures.
- ◆ Listen to a story read to you by a grown up or a big brother or sister.
- ◆ Watch Playschool on ABC2 at 9am, 11am or 3.30pm and/or Sesame Street at 9.30am
- ◆ Count to 10 as often as possible - you can count anything !
- ◆ Whiteboard - trace your name & draw a picture.
- ◆ Be safe, show respect and display high standards at home.

**WEEKLY TASKS** : Please complete the activities which have sheets in your child's Kindy@Home book and as many as you choose of the other tasks.

### LISTENING EARS

Glue your headband so it fits around your head. Write your name on the line of the writing sheet and glue it in the middle of the band. Cut the ears apart & glue them on either side. Wear your listening ears and draw the things you hear that are loud and soft.



### BABY BEAR HOUSE

Can you make a house for your baby bear using boxes and containers ? Make sure it is big enough for Baby Bear to fit inside. Can you make windows and a door ?



### RAINBOW HUNT



Use your 6 popsticks to find things around the house that are the same colours.

Can you find 5 things for each colour ? Count the things you find to make sure you have 5.




Can you draw you playing on a rainy day with a rainbow in the sky ?

### 5 little baby bears jumping on the bed

Make your rainbow baby bears and Mummy Bear puppets.

Say the rhyme and make your bears tell the story. Count your bears each time one falls off the bed.



### SPLAT GAME



Play the game with some people in your family. Each person makes a creature with the playdoh. Put some crosses on squares on the game board to be SPLAT spots. If someone lands on a SPLAT spot they get to choose someone else's creature to squash & they have to miss a turn to make it again !




### PAINT THE SWAN READ STORY BOOK & COLOURING BOOK

Read your special book from Red the Roo to your Baby Bear and do some of the pages in your Red the Roo colouring book.

Have a grown up read you the questions on the drawing pages and talk about what you draw.


Colour Mummy Bear purple and each baby bear in one of the colours of your popsticks. Colour the bed in rainbow colours.  
Cut out the bears and tape each of them to a popstick and act out the rhyme.

## 5 Little Baby Bears

5 little baby bears  
Jumping on the bed  
(say colour of bear) baby bear fell off ....  
And bumped its head  
Called for Mummy Bear  
And Mummy Bear said ....  
"No more baby bears  
jumping on the bed !"

*Count the baby bears left on the bed and repeat with the  
new number of baby bears jumping on the bed.  
When there are NO baby bears left jumping say :*

No little baby bears  
Jumping on the bed  
None one fell off ....  
And bumped its head  
Called for Mummy Bear  
And Mummy Bear said ....  
"Time for ALL baby bears to go to sleep instead !"

### HOME HELPER


Help do some chores around the house and draw them on the sheet glued in your book.

You colour in a numbers on your Race to 100 chart in the front of your book for each job you do.



### PAINT THE SWAN REAd STORY BOOK & COLOURING BOOK

Read your special book from Red the Roo to your Baby Bear and do some more pages in your colouring book. Have a grown up read you the questions on the drawing pages and talk about what you draw.



### PLAYDOH & EGG CARDS

Use your egg shapes and playdoh or plasticine to make spotty easter eggs.

Roll the dice and make that number of little balls of playdoh and squash them into spots on one egg. Roll again and makes spots on your next egg until they are all spotty.

Can you count ALL the spots on your eggs ?



### FORKY'S FRIEND SPOONY

Use your ball of plasticine, spoon, plain popsticks, straws and googly eyes to make your own 'Spoony'.

You can make a Forky and Knifey too if you have any plastic cutlery - or you can cut the shape from card.



### EGG GUESSING GAMES



**Game 1**- Ask a grown up, big brother or sister to hide something little in your egg.

Can you guess what it is by shaking it & listening to the clues they give you ?



**Game 2** - put 5 small things on a table and look at them.

Close your eyes and have a grown up hide 1 thing in your egg. Can you guess which one is missing ?
